Registration for rodeo weekend will be Friday at the Expo arena, front foyer, from 5PM-7PM

Due to county ordinance, PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED INSIDE THE VIEWING AREA OF THE VENUE. Please be prepared to keep your pets inside your RV or camping area. Pets will not be allowed to run free in any area of the rodeo grounds.

Late Registration, Late Fee Policy and Payout

Late registrations will be accepted with no penalty. Rough stock riding contestants are encouraged pre-register, but will be allowed to register at the Expo arena and compete after the close of the online registration

Payout for Zia Regional Rodeo will follow IGRA guidelines There is no added money available for 2020 contestant pay-out at this time, but stay tuned for updates if that changes!

Horse Information

Stall Fees/Horse Information:

Early Horse check in is allowed Thursday after 12 noon, however, an additional \$25.00 fee for a stall Thursday night will apply

Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights are included in registration for one stall. This constitutes the "weekend"

\$25 per additional horse stall used for competition for the weekend, payable at REGISTRATION

\$60 per additional horse NOT used in competition for the weekend, payable at REGISTRATION

\$60 per tack stall for the weekend, payable at REGISTRATION

There will be a \$50 late fee for contestants who did not reserve an adequate number of horse stalls in their pre-registration entry.

Jonathan Suder and Patrick Terry will be on site Thursday after 12:00 NOON and Friday to help check in horses and RVs. Contact information listed above

Shavings available at Feed Store on the grounds. Call 505-934-2681 and make sure you mention that you're in the **Palomino Barns** and give them your stall number for delivery

The arena will be groomed Friday after Rodeo School

RV Camping Information

COVERED RV Parking at the arena is available on a first come, first served basis. This year RVs will park under the dairy barns next to the arena

Spaces become available after 12:00 noon on Thursday

There is a \$35 per day fee for spaces with 30-amp power. These spaces support air conditioning, and have water hookups

Camping fees will be collected by at check-in
Sorry, there are no showers available
